
SMART P ARKING

Your Guide to Safer Parking in Rockingham.



The City's Local Laws are designed to maximise the use of available space and to provide access to parking for all motorists, with regard to the requirements of businesses, visitors, residents and traffic management.

Illegal parking can be dangerous to pedestrians, cyclists and other road users and causes frustration, inconvenience and irritation.











Refer to these common offences to avoid future infringements.

- Parking in an ACROD bay without the required permit
- Parking of a vehicle on a thoroughfare for purpose of sale (i.e. road, verge or road reserve)

Not adhering to time restrictions

- Parking or stopping in a bus stop
- Parking contrary to signs and or road markings (i.e. no stopping etc.)
- Parking your vehicle in a public place for a period exceeding 24 hours may result in the vehicle being towed and impounded
- Parking on verges without the permission of the adjoining land owner or occupier
- Parking within 10 metres of a building property line at an intersection
- Parking/stopping against the flow of traffic when parking on the road and in a marked bay
- Parking within 10 metres prior to and 20 metres after a pedestrian crossing
- 6 Obstructing driveways/public access ways
- Double parking.
- Parking on footpaths or on median strips
