At the City of Rockingham we love it so much we've decided to extend it throughout the entire year.

It's easy to come together and celebrate our neighbours: cook a BBQ, hold a bake off, celebrate in style over a high tea, host an after school activity, gather your dogs for a puppy party or group walk. Keep it simple over cake and coffee or get creative and design your own activity.

How to register

- 1 Register with the City of Rockingham three weeks prior to your activity
- 2 Host an alcohol-free activity
- 3 Apply for up to a \$40 reimbursement

Tips for Hosts

- Take the time to introduce yourself to neighbours prior to the event. People are more likely to come along and feel more comfortable if they have already met you.
- Introduce people as they arrive. Provide name tags.
- To keep costs down and get everyone involved ask people to bring a plate of food to share.
- The City of Rockingham has games available for loan through our local libraries that you can use at your activity. Library memberships are free!
- Keep it simple. It doesn't have to be a huge event. Make it as big or as small as you like.

This means you and your neighbours can get together to host an activity and the City of Rockingham will contribute up to \$40 towards the cost of food.

The City will supply invitations, merchandise and a Neighbours Unite T-shirt for the host.
