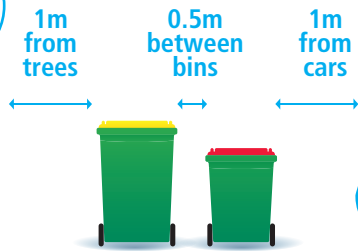


WHERE TO PUT YOUR BIN?..



..AND DON'T FORGET



Place on kerb by 6am on collection day.



Keep the weight of the bin under 70kg.



Avoid overfilling to ensure the lid can close.

OTHER HANDY HINTS

- Place bins on the kerb with wheels facing the house.
- Return bins to your property as soon as possible
- Store bins in a shaded area
- Rubbish must be free flowing, do not jam waste into your bin
- Lids must be closed
- Wrap all moist and perishable foods in newspaper before placing into your red-lidded waste bin
- Clean bins regularly
- There are no changes to bin collection days for all public holidays.

BETTER BINS

Through the Better Bins program the City upgraded its residential bin service in May – June 2017. The three bin system is recognised as best practise by the Waste Authority because the waste is sorted at the point of disposal in the home. This provides a cleaner recycling stream and diverts additional recyclables and green waste from landfill. Residents play their part in a sustainable future by sorting their waste and recyclables at home. We aim to exceed the state governments 65% recovery target by 2020.

DISPOSAL OF OTHER ITEMS

RECYCLING BIN




The contents of the recycling bin (yellow lid) is collected fortnightly by SUEZ Recycling and Recovery and processed at their Bibra Lake Resource Recovery Park.

 **Steel cans, aluminium cans, empty aerosols and aluminium foil**

 **Glass bottles and jars**
(rinse and remove lids)

 **Paper, cardboard, newspapers and magazines**

 **Plastic bottles, containers, plastic food wrappers**

Plastic packaging that falls under the plastic identification codes can now be recycled:



This includes items for example; bread bags, frozen food wrapping, chip packets and cereal box liners, polystyrene (not balls), milk bottles, and margarine containers.

REMEMBER

- Rinse or empty recyclables
- Flatten boxes only
- Lids can be put back on bottles once emptied
- Place separately in bin, not bagged

- × NO bagged recyclables or bin liners
- × NO food waste
- × NO green waste
- × NO liquids
- × NO textiles or clothing
- × NO nappies

GREEN WASTE BIN



The green waste bin is emptied on the alternate fortnight to the recycling bin by SUEZ Recycling and Recovery. Green waste is pre-sorted at the Organics Resource Recovery Facility in Bibra Lake, before it is transported to the North Bannister Resource Recovery Park for composting.

 **Small prunings (maximum 400mm length by 200mm diameter)**

 **Lawn clippings**

 **Sticks and twigs**

 **Leaves and flowers**

 **Weeds**

REMEMBER

- No food or animal waste
- Place loosely into bin, not bagged or tied with string
- No sand, rocks or building materials
- No large logs

WASTE BIN



The waste bin (red lid) is emptied weekly by the City of Rockingham and taken to the Millar Road Landfill Facility, Baldivis.

 **General household waste and food scraps**

 **Nappies and other personal hygiene items (no sharps)**

 **Ceramics**

 **Animal litter or droppings**

 **Rags and textiles**

 **Broken toys**



Please do not place any hazardous items in any of your bins. Hazardous Items are highlighted below.

- × NO liquids or oils
- × NO hot ashes (to avoid fires)
- × NO construction, demolition or building materials (no bricks, sand, soil, concrete, rocks or asbestos)
- × NO medical waste or needles
- × NO batteries
- × NO hazardous household waste (petrol, flammable liquids, paints, motor oils, fluids, garden chemicals, poisons, pool chemicals, cleaners, acids, bleaches, ammonia, medicines or gas cylinders).
