Top 10 tips to make it tougher for crooks!

Keep all doors and windows locked at all times, even when at home, including garages and sheds.

Keep valuable items such as computers, laptops, stereos and mobile phones out of sight (mark them with a UV pen or have them engraved).



Do not leave spare keys hidden outside your home. Leave them with a trusted neighbour, friend or relative.



Ensure your vehicle is always locked and do not leave valuables in your car.



Try to park your car in well-lit areas.

• Have your keys in your hand before you get to your car and be aware of your surroundings. When shopping, make sure your bag is closed and do not leave it unattended in your trolley.



Always report suspicious behaviours to the police on 131 444 or Crime Stoppers.



Keep your yard maintained to reduce places to hide and increase visibility from the street.
