The City of Rockingham will be hosting a range of activities and workshops at various locations in celebration of International Day of People with Disability.

This will include microenterprise pop up stalls in collaboration with three local shopping centres: Rockingham Centre, Secret Harbour Square, and Warnbro Centre.

Pop up stall dates at each location						
Rockingham Centre	Thursday 28 November - Sunday 1 December.	Rockingham Centre is a large and busy shopping centre that can get noisy. The available stall space is located outside Target, which is expected to be crowded at this time of year. If you are sensitive to noise and crowds, consider applying for stall space at one of the other available locations.				
		Stall space at Rockingham Centre is very limited. Successful applicants will only be able to have one table for one day at this location. This is to give as many microenterprises as possible a chance to participate. The provided tables will be box tables, which are smaller than standard trestle tables.				
Secret Harbour Square	Tuesday 3 December - Saturday 7 December.	Secret Harbour Square is a moderately sized shopping centre, and is fairly quiet but still has quite regular foot traffic. They regularly host small business stalls. This space is a good option for people sensitive to noise and crowds.				
Warnbro Centre	Wednesday 4 December - Sunday 8 December.	Warnbro Centre is quite a small shopping centre. The stall space will be outside Coles, so will be the quietest of the three locations. This space is a good option for new microenterprises and people sensitive to noise.

Microenterprise Stallholder Terms and Conditions:

- 1. Submitting your completed Expression of Interest form does not guarantee a stall.
- 2. Stallholders are required to provide at least one week's notice prior to the event if withdrawing.
- 3. Stallholders are responsible for taking their own sales (via cash or bank card purchase).
- 4. Additional requirements must be requested in writing by expression of interest closing date as stated. Requests after this date will not be considered.
- 5. You will be allocated a space on the day. All allocations are non-negotiable.
- 6. Set up of your table begins at 8am and must be completed by 10am. Your stall should remain open until 4pm but this can be flexible if required.
- 7. You, staff members and/or volunteers working at your stall will be responsible for securing your products and/or equipment. The City of Rockingham, Secret Harbour Square, Warnbro Centre and Rockingham Centre will not be held liable for any stolen or damaged products and/or equipment.
