

**Entrants must submit work in accordance with the Terms and Conditions as set out in this document.**

1. Artists must be over the age of 18 to enter.
2. Artists must be Western Australian residents since 1 January 2022.
3. All entries must be received by the City of Rockingham online form by **midnight Sunday 28 May 2023**. No late entries will be accepted into the competition.
4. All communications from the City will be via email to the address nominated in your entry form. Receipt of entries will be confirmed via email within five (5) business days. You will not receive an automatic confirmation.
5. City employees and their immediate family are not eligible to apply.

### **ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS**

6. One (1) artwork per artist may be submitted. Entries are open to any sculptural or 3D artwork, excluding installation.
7. Artworks must not exceed 40cm on the longest side and must not exceed 10kg.
8. All artworks must be comprised of at least 65% recycled materials (reused, repurposed, recovered, salvaged, and/or found items). Single-use products should be reused and not newly purchased.
9. Artworks must be complete to enter.
10. Artworks must have been completed no earlier than 1 January 2022.
11. Artworks must not have been exhibited in a competition in the Perth metropolitan and the City areas (including online). The Perth metropolitan area is defined as extending to, and including, Yanchep, Mundaring, and Armadale.
12. Artists are not permitted to display brands, logos of their sponsors, or any other commercial material on or around their artwork.
13. Artworks with audio aspects must be disclosed in the entry form and approved by the City prior to exhibition.

### **AWARDS**

All awards to be awarded at the Judge's discretion. All awards are non-acquisitive.

**Major Award**

\$10,000

Overall excellence in recycled sculpture with a 30% visual aluminium component.

**Innovation Award**

\$5,000

Use of recycled materials in an innovative or unexpected way.

**Sustainability Award**

\$5,000

Artwork that supports the concept of sustainability in its message.

**Maquette and Small Sculpture Award**

\$2,500

Excellence in small scale sculpture, creatively using recycled components.

**Local Resident Award**

\$2,000

Local artist residing in the Rockingham district.

**People's Choice Award – Main Exhibition**

\$1,000

Presented to the artist whose work received the most votes from members of the public.

**People's Choice Award – Maquette and Small Sculpture Exhibition**

\$500

Presented to the artist whose work received the most votes from members of the public.

**People's Choice Award – Schools Exhibition**

Presented to the artist whose work received the most votes from members of the public.

**ARTWORK SELECTION**

14. The Selection Panel's decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into. Lobbying the Curator, Selection Panel, or City staff will result in disqualification.

15. Due to the exhibition's public location, artworks must be suitable for viewing by all age groups. The City reserves the right to refuse entry of artwork on the basis of inappropriateness.
16. Works deemed unsafe will be refused entry.
17. Artists will be notified of the outcome of their entry by **Friday 16 June 2023** via email.
18. Entrants must submit the entered work for Castaways Sculpture Awards Exhibition if selected. Only artworks detailed on the entry form and in the submission image will be accepted. Any other artwork will not be accepted.
19. Selected artists must provide an image of their artwork suitable for publication in the Castaways catalogue by Friday 18 August 2023. Images not received by this time will not be printed in the catalogue. Artists who submit high quality images of their artwork prior to the deadline are most likely to be featured in promotional material and social media campaigns.

## **DELIVERY OF WORK**

20. Artworks must be delivered to the Rockingham Arts Centre, 11 Kent Street Rockingham, on **Tuesday 17 October 2023**.
21. Artworks must be delivered bubble-wrapped, with the artists name and phone number clearly marked on the outside.
22. Artworks that upon arrival are not finished to the standard agreed upon, or expected by the Curator; or to the satisfaction of either the Curator or City staff, will be refused and will not be installed.

## **EXHIBITION**

23. The City will provide security over the period of exhibition, installation and de-installation.
24. The City and exhibition staff have the right to remove artworks from the site for any reason, including but not limited to: public safety, damage or potential damage to work, or for the cohesive curation of the exhibition.
25. Artists must be available to repair or remove any damaged artworks from the site within 24 hours of the damage being reported. No artworks are to be left at the Rockingham Arts Centre.
26. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

27. The City holds no responsibility for damage caused to artworks during transportation to the exhibition site, installation, de-installation, and while the works are on display.
28. All directions or requests from the Curator, the City or other public authorities must be complied with.

## **COPYRIGHT AND PROMOTION**

29. The City reserves the right to reproduce images of works for promotional, marketing or educational purposes at no cost to the City.
30. By entering an artwork the artist agrees to allow the City to publish the artist's name, artwork title, and artist's statement in connection to their entry.
31. All artwork submitted must be the original work of the artist. Artworks cannot be copied or referenced either wholly or in part from any external article. Artworks cannot infringe the copyright, moral rights or other rights of any third party.
32. Artists must not issue press releases without prior written consent from the City.

## **SALE OF ARTWORK**

33. The sale of works will be managed by the City. On no account are artists to negotiate their own sales.
34. All sales are subject to a 20% commission. On no account are artists to accept funds for their own sales. All sales will be finalised within 45 days of the close of the exhibition or the date of the sale, whichever is later.
35. The City does not guarantee the sale of works.
36. Any further commission or sale arising directly from the exhibition within a period of three months following the close of the exhibition will attract a commission of 20%.
37. If a work is sold, the participating artist will take full responsibility for ensuring their work is in a condition that will meet the buyer's expectations. The artist takes full responsibility for the delivery of sold work.
38. Artists who sell their artwork will be required to complete and sign documents provided by the City to process the transaction. Incomplete information or delays in returning documentation will result in delays with payment.

## AWARDS

39. The Judges' decision for award winners is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into. Lobbying the Curator, judges, or City staff will result in disqualification and preclude entry in future Castaways Sculpture Awards.
40. An artwork cannot be awarded more than one award in the same year.
41. Winners will be announced at the Castaways Sculpture Awards Presentation (with the exception of the People's Choice Awards), and then published on [rockingham.wa.gov.au](http://rockingham.wa.gov.au).
42. Artists who receive an award will be required to complete and sign documents provided by the City to process the transaction. Incomplete information or delays in returning documentation will result in delays with payment.
43. Canvassing the public for People's Choice Awards votes will result in disqualification from the People's Choice Award and future Castaways Sculpture Awards.
44. The Castaways Sculpture Awards Presentation is scheduled for **Saturday 21 October 2023** but may be subject to change.
45. The Castaways Sculpture Awards Presentation is by invitation only. Exhibiting artists and one (1) guest will be invited. Requests for additional guests will be denied.

## COLLECTION OF WORKS

46. Artworks must be collected from the Rockingham Arts Centre, 11 Kent Street Rockingham, on **Monday 30 October 2023**.
47. Uncollected artworks will be disposed of, at a cost to the artist. Requests to collect work at an earlier date will be denied.
