### Visiting Castaways

The Schools Competition exhibition is displayed at Churchill Park, behind the Castaways Information Tent, at the Rockingham Foreshore, Rockingham Beach Road. The Main Exhibition is also located at the Rockingham Foreshore.

Bus Parking is available a short stroll away, behind the Rockingham Arts Centre, off 11 Kent Street Rockingham (refer to the map below).

The City of Rockingham is offering up to four Rockingham schools a reimbursement of \$300 toward bus hire fees.

### On-site facilities

Public toilets and a water fountain are located on site. Churchill Park and the adjoining Bell Park offers ample grass and shade for lunch or activities. There are also multiple cafes and ice-cream stores nearby.
