Recruit Event Volunteers through Rockingham Volunteer Centre (RVC)

The RVC provides support and a link between local community groups, sporting clubs and not for profit organisations with volunteer programs and local community members looking for a volunteer role. If eligible, your club can receive:

- Free membership to the RVC
- Assistance recruiting event volunteers through managed advertising and promotion

Community Connector Program

To combat loneliness in the City of Rockingham we are piloting a Club Connector program. Participating clubs nominate one or more members who are willing to act as the 'club connector', their role is to be the first point of contact for people wanting to join a club, but who may need an extra level of support – like a buddy system.

Each 'club connector' will need to provide:

- A photo
- Contact details
- Availability (this can be when they regularly meet at the club)
- Something about them – whatever they would like to share that might make people more comfortable reaching out.
