

City of Rockingham Toy Library – Conditions of Use

City of Rockingham Toy Library is available only to City of Rockingham library members over the age of 18 years. Use of the library is granted under the following conditions of use. Failure to abide by these conditions may result in suspension from the Toy Library either temporarily or on a permanent basis.

Borrowing Limits

Members may borrow up to a total of six (6) items for a period of four (4) weeks in addition to their general City of Rockingham Library loan limit of 20 items.

Care of Toys

Toy library users are responsible for the care of all toys loaned to them. All items borrowed from the Toy Library must be:

- Returned in the same condition as when borrowed. If you notice any damage or missing parts when unpacking the toys you must advise the library immediately.
- Toys must be wiped down with hot soapy water before returning. Toys will not be accepted for return unless they are clean and ready for loan again.
- Toys should be kept inside except for those specifically designed for outdoor use.
- Batteries should be removed before returning the toys.

Responsibility for Loss or Damage

If a toy is lost or damaged beyond repair a replacement fee may be charged to the full value of the item. Borrowers will also have the option of replacing the toy themselves with same or similar item in agreement with the Branch Librarian.

Toys that are returned with missing parts or which require repair may incur an administration fee.

Loans, Renewals and Returns

Toys may only be borrowed during the City of Rockingham Toy Library opening hours. Toy library items may not be renewed and must be returned to Rockingham Library by their due date.

Toys can only be returned to the Rockingham Library.

Toys can be returned to the Rockingham Library at any time during normal library opening hours – returns are not restricted to City of Rockingham Toy Library opening hours.

Disclaimer

Toys borrowed should be used in accordance of the purpose for which they are intended and by children of an appropriate age and level of understanding with appropriate supervision. Please note that some toys have small parts and are not suitable for children under three years of age. Plastic bags can be dangerous. To avoid suffocation please keep plastic bags away from babies and small children. We recommend that children using ride on toys wear a helmet. The City of Rockingham will take no responsibility for injury or damage caused by any equipment borrowed.

These Conditions of Use are subject to change and changes will be communicated to all City of Rockingham Toy Library users as required.
