

Stepping Out in Rockingham

Baldivis Nature Reserve Trail



Baldivis Nature Reserve Trail

Distance: 2 km / 2500 steps
Time: 20 - 25 minutes (one way)
Start: Baldivis Rd
Surface: Mulched

To access the Baldivis Nature Reserve Trail you will find parking at the Baldivis Recreation Centre, corner of Baldivis Road and Fifty Road. You won't miss the big timber sign at the entrance of the walk trail. A very colourful information panel provides an interesting read on the vegetation, bird life and wildflowers that you are likely to see depending on the season. A sandy, mulched trail leads you around the back of the Baldivis Oval with some trail markers along the way. The trail is narrow to begin, and widens as you venture along the 2 kilometre trail. Remnant natural bushland exists, including jarrah, sheoak and banksia trees and is protected in this fragile environment. There is an opportunity to loop the trail by heading to the left (east) at the bottom of Baldivis Oval & walking north past the tennis courts back to the carpark.
