

Review and Objection

Have you received correspondence from the City advising that you have a right to apply for a review of and/ or object against a decision?

A separate review process exists for infringement appeals - visit www.rockingham.wa.gov.au/infringementappeal

Application refused

Permit cancelled

Notice issued requiring you to take specific action

Apply for a **REVIEW**

State Administration Tribunal (SAT)

eLodgement via www.sat.justice.wa.gov.au

Strict timeframes apply – Refer to SAT website

Application considered with or without a hearing

Possible outcomes (not limited to):

- Decision based on documentation
- Conference
- Mediation

Lodge an **OBJECTION**

City of Rockingham

Submit **Form 4** to Chief Executive Officer via customer@rockingham.wa.gov.au

Within 28 days after the right to object arose

Objection dealt with by Council (or Council authorised committee)

Possible outcomes:

- Dismiss the objection
- Vary the decision objected to
- Revoke the decision objected to, with or without substitution or further referral
