Support Navigating Aged Care

Care Finders provide free, one-on-one support to help understand and access the aged care system. To be eligible for Care Finders a person must:

- be aged 65 or over
- not have a trusted carer or support person to provide assistance, and
- be eligible to receive government-funded aged care.

People at risk of, or experiencing homelessness, can access Care Finders from the age of 50. Specialised services are also available for First Nations people, culturally and linguistically diverse people, and people living with dementia.
