Rockingham plays a significant role in Western Australia's naval defence industry.

With a proud history of supporting the Australian Defence Force, Rockingham plays a significant role in WA's naval defence industry, acting as a critical node, hosting Defence primes (including Saab, Thales, and Leonardo), and home to a large number of naval personnel, their families and veterans.

Its strategic location between HMAS Stirling (Australia's largest naval base), Australian Marine Complex (AMC) Henderson (WA's shipbuilding, repair and maintenance hub) and future Westport makes Rockingham an excellent location for Defence industry and Defence-related businesses.

Rockingham is also the southern part of the Western Trade Coast (WTC), a key industrial region integral to both the state and national economy. WTC encompasses an array of strategic industries, including advanced manufacturing, chemical production, critical minerals processing, and energy.



Opportunity for other state, national and international training and research institutions to provide undergraduate and post graduate degrees, and industry-backed research, development and prototyping capability.


