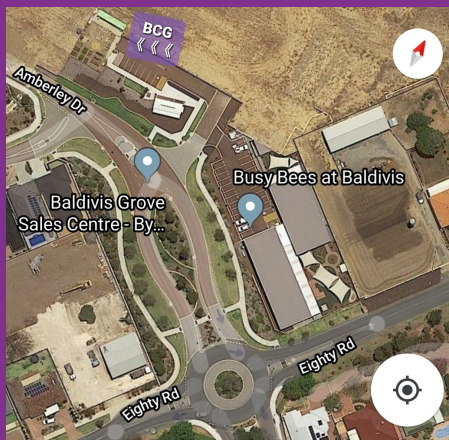

HISTORY

After years of planning, Frasers Property Australia offered to provide a new location to BCG in March 2018.

On the 9th June Frasers land was handed over to the BCG committee

Within 2 weeks, our first lot of family garden beds were placed and filled.

The first community beds were built in the beginning of August along with the release of private family plots.

We then began holding workshops and continued establishing garden beds, compost bins and worm farms.

Grants have been approved and used to supply products, equipment and install reticulation.

Many behind the scenes costs are involved such as insurance and maintenance costs.

Grant funding, along with membership fees, sponsorships and donations are required to help keep BCG operating and growing.

Towards the end of 2019, Fraser's granted us an extension. We are now in the process of planning and developing the new section.
