

Bee Keeping Requirements:

Residents are permitted to keep bees on their property without any approvals from the City of Rockingham, as long as the bees do not create a nuisance.

Residents that would like to keep bees should consider the following, to minimise the likelihood of the bees causing a nuisance:

- Hives should be located as far from other buildings, footpaths and public places. It is recommended that a 10m distance be achieved,
- Hives should be located at least 5m from boundary fences;
- The hive should be enclosed on all sides; and
- An adequate and permanent supply of water should be provided on the property, and within 10m of the hive.

If the City receives verified complaints of bees at a property creating a nuisance, then the City may issue a Notice under the Local Government Act for the removal of the bees.

Beekeeper Registration and Hive Brands:

In order to maintain high biosecurity standards, beehives need to be registered with the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development.

To be a beekeeper in Western Australia it is a legal requirement that you register with the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD).

Nuisance bees:

Bee swarms are relatively common in September, October and November in Perth.

When bees swarm they are unlikely to sting. When a cluster of bees is seen hanging on a tree branch or similar, they are generally in a transition, waiting for the scout bees to find a new location. This might take a few days, but almost invariably they will move on their own accord.

If a bee swarm becomes established, there are many beekeepers who are available to remove the cluster of bees as opposed to destroying them. The City has a list of bee removalists, who generally operate for a small fee.
