PLEASE KEEP YOUR VERGE CLEAR

Waste can only be placed on your verge no more than two days prior to your scheduled collection date.

Waste left behind after the collection has passed is your responsibility and must be removed from your verge within seven days or enforcement action may be taken.

More Information

Non-conforming waste

Residents can take their non-conforming waste to the Millar Road Landfill and Recycling Facility, open seven days from 7.30am – 4pm (closed Christmas Day and Good Friday). Disposal of e-waste will incur a fee.

Fees payable by tip pass, cash or EFTPOS. Metals and recyclable items can be dropped off for free.

General Waste Verge Collection

The following **WILL** be collected:

- ✓ Whitegoods (fridges and freezers) collected separately
- ✓ E-waste (TVs and computer hardware) collected separately
- ✓ Old furniture (with glass removed) (up to 1.5 m in length)
- ✓ Timber (up to 1.5 m in length)
- ✓ Mattresses collected separately
- ✓ Other metal collected separately.

The following **WILL NOT** be collected:

- × Waste exceeding 1.5 m in length
- ✗ Green waste, bags of leaves or grass, stumps or palm logs
- × Food waste
- × Car bodies, vehicle parts or tyres
- × Batteries or items with integrated batteries
- × Paints, chemicals, oils or gas bottles
- ★ Asbestos, Hardifence, Super Six (fibre cement) products, bricks, sand, cement, concrete or building rubble

★ All glass including plate glass, shower screens, glass tables or mirrors.

Place out no more than two days prior to collection date.

Maximum total per property is 2 m³



Green WasteVerge Collection


The following **WILL** be collected:

Tree and shrub prunings to a maximum of 1.5 m in length and 350 mm diameter.

The following **WILL NOT** be collected:

- ★ Leaves and lawn clippings
- Bags or boxes of leaves and grass clippings, weeds or root materials
- X Sand and soil materials
- X Dug out lawn
- Any branches exceeding 1.5 m in length or 350 mm in diameter
- **≍** General waste, junk or whitegoods.

Place out no more than two days prior to collection date.



Verge Collection Do's and Don'ts

PLEASE:

- Place waste neatly on your own verge no more than two days prior to your scheduled collection date.
- Place waste collected separately (fridges, other metals, e-waste and mattresses) in separate piles from your other waste.
- Place on your own verge by Monday 6am on your scheduled start date for your area as the contractor will only check the verge once.
- ✓ Allow seven working days for collection.
- Keep on checking your pile as it is your responsibility throughout the collection.

PLEASE DON'T:

- ➤ Obstruct the footpath, your bin service or the line of sight of pedestrians, cyclists and cars.
- ➤ Place waste too close to fences, trees, cars, power domes, or other objects that may get damaged when waste is collected.
- × Place your waste inside your property line.
- Place your waste on any other verge as it will not be collected from vacant land and public reserves.
- × Place out more than the allowed volume.

Verge waste is collected from your verge with machinery which can damage artificial turf.

Weekly Kerbside Waste Collections



Your bin collection schedule is changing from 30 June 2025. Each week place two bins on your kerb by 6am. Your green-lidded FOGO bin will be collected weekly, and your recycling and general waste will be collected fortnightly, on alternating weeks.

Other Ways to Dispose of Your Waste

Tip Passes

If you have tip passes, you can drop off items at the Millar Road Landfill and Recycling Facility outside of your collection dates. City of Rockingham ratepayers receive four tip passes each year on their rates notice. Each tip pass can be used for up to 1.5 m³ of either general or green waste. If you're a tenant, check with your landlord.

Hazardous Waste

Unsure where to dispose of your hazardous waste? Hazardous household waste can be dropped off for free (or for a small fee) at the Millar Road Landfill and Recycling Facility. This ensures it is reused, recycled or disposed of safely.

This includes:

Batteries (including dry cell, lithium and car batteries)

Household chemicals (including cleaning, pool and garden chemicals)

Flares (up to 10) Smoke detectors

Fluoro tubes and light fittings

Pesticides and solvents

Paint E-waste
