Recycling A–Z

Learn how to recycle in the City of Rockingham and maximise material recovery.

Yellow lidded recycling bin

Remember to remove lids from bottles, flatten boxes, clean and dry items before placing them loosely in your recycling bin. Scrunchable soft plastics cannot be recycled and should be placed in your red lidded waste bin.



Aluminium cans, coffee or Milo tins, balled aluminium foil



Paper (not shredded), magazines, newspapers, junk mail, flattened cardboard boxes and egg cartons



Plastic containers e.g. yoghurt, ice cream or margarine containers



Steel cans, tins and lids



Plastic bottles

Glass jars and bottles (lids removed and rinsed)

Millar Road Landfill and Recycling Facility

Not all recyclables can be placed in the recycling bin due to safety concerns. Drop the following items off to **Millar Road Landfill and Recycling Facility**:



Batteries including dry cell batteries, lithium batteries



Household chemicals including cleaning, pool and garden chemicals




Old decorative and architectural paint



Other hazardous items including fluoro light fittings and tubes,

Aerosols, flares, smoke detectors



and red fire extinguishers

Containers for Change

Tip: Containers with 10c mark are accepted. Be sure to remove all lids. Visit **containersforchange.com.au/wa** for more information.



Plastic: Water bottles, soft drinks, juice and flavoured milk bottles, and sports drinks



Drink cans: Soft drink, carbonated beverages, energy drinks, beers and pre-mixed spirits



Glass: Water, beer, pre-mixed spirits and soft drink bottles



Drink cartons: Flavoured milk cartons, juice cartons, juice boxes and boxed water



Other: Juice pouches and water casks

Recycle right A-Z list

- Go to recycleright.wa.gov.au
- Select A–Z list from the drop-down menu
- Choose the correct bin system
- Enter your item and press search
- Recycle right!
