The City of Rockingham is inviting all organisations and individuals interested in an age-friendly world to get involved in the Seniors and Carers Expo.

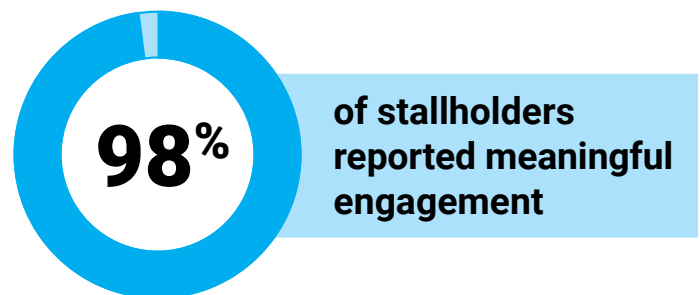
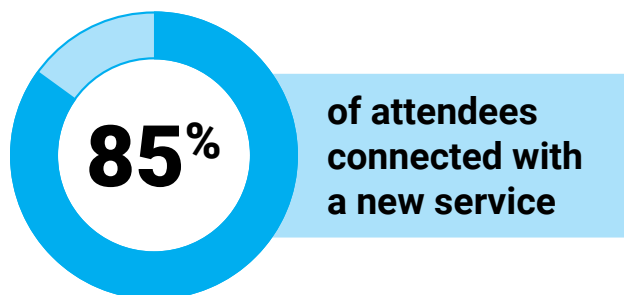
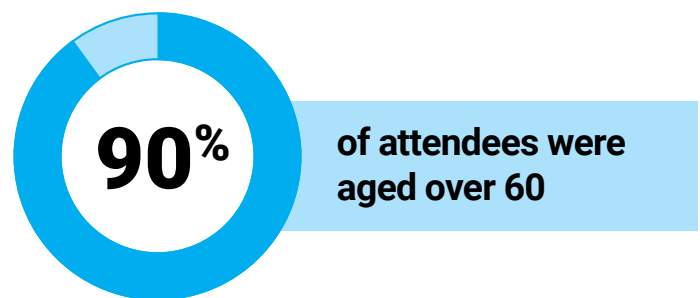
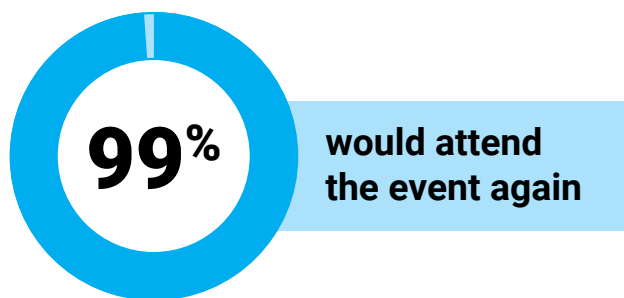

Stallholder Terms and Conditions

1. All stalls must be **set up by no later than 9.30am**. Full details about the set up times and locations will be sent in the weeks prior to the event.
2. **Stalls MUST NOT pack up before 2pm**. Organisations packing up early, without notifying event staff, may be excluded from future events.
3. **Strictly no sales**. Requests to fundraise (including genuine fundraising raffles) must be made in writing, including the prizes offered, and submitted to The Event Mill at least seven days prior to the event. **Stalls found to breach the sales condition will be asked to leave immediately and be excluded from all future events**.
4. Stalls holding approved raffles must contact winners directly.
5. Staff and volunteers **must only park in the dedicated stallholder parking area**. The location will be indicated in event information sent to you prior to the event.
6. All **additional equipment** must be requested on this application and submitted before the application closing date for consideration.
7. Stalls will be allocated according to the type indicated on application. Event staff will allocate a non-negotiable **stall number and location**.
8. Equipment/products for stalls must be managed by your staff/volunteers. The City of Rockingham and The Event Mill bear no **responsibility for loss or damage** of items brought to the event.
9. The Seniors and Carers Expo is a **smoke-free and alcohol-free** event (including vaping). Failure to comply will result in expulsion from the event and the organisation may be excluded from future events.
10. **No stiletto heels** are to be worn as they will damage the venue's basketball courts.
11. Registration fee of \$20 is **non-refundable after Friday 11 September 2026***. Withdrawals less than seven days prior to the event may result in your organisation being excluded from future events.
12. **Event details are subject to change**.
